### **DISTRIBUTION OF HOME STUDY MATERIALS TO LEARNERS**


Following the statement made by the Hon. Minister for Education and Sports on the distribution of home study materials to learners, the Ministry, through the National Curriculum Development Centre and the Uganda National Examination Board, developed self-study materials to help learners continue learning during the COVID-19 lockdown.

The materials are now being delivered to all the Districts of Uganda. The distribution of materials has been guided by the Uganda Bureau of Statistics (UBOS) population data, showing the number of children between the ages of 6-18 in each district and sub county. You are, therefore, requested to use your district administrative structures at sub-county, parish and village levels to locate the learners and establish their classes so that the relevant materials are delivered to their respective homes.

The DEO and the Education department at the district are expected to support this intervention.

Delivery forms are being issued for acknowledgment of receipt of the study materials at each level, from the district to LC1.

You are further requested to ensure that places in your district, which are not covered by UBC Radio and Television and where learners may not be able to access lesson broadcasts, are given priority in distribution of the materials.
