3. Bidding will be conducted in accordance with the Open Domestic bidding method contained in the Government of Uganda's Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets Act, 2003 for National and Local firms.

Bidding documents in **English** may be purchased by interested bidders on submission of a written application to the address below at 8(a) upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **US\$100,000 (Uganda Shillings One Hundred Thousand Only)** per Lot. The method of payment will be through obtaining a Bank Payment Advise Forms from the cashier on 5th Floor, Embassy House and pay at the designated Bank with effect from 11<sup>th</sup> January, 2021. On presentation of proof of payment, bidding documents may then be collected from the Procurement and Disposal unit Room 7.2 with effect from **11<sup>th</sup> January, 2021**.

6. Bids must be delivered to the address below at 8(a) at or before at **11:00 am 09<sup>th</sup> February, 2021**. All bids must be accompanied with a bid security in the format of an unconditional bank guarantee and in the values indicated in the table above. Bid securities must be valid until 30<sup>th</sup> August 2021. Late bids shall be rejected. " The Bids will be opened on 9<sup>th</sup> February 2021 at 11:30am at the address in 8b. Bidders' Representatives will witness the opening via Zoom and the details will be forwarded on 8<sup>th</sup> February 2021.

7. There shall be a pre-bid meeting via zoom on 21<sup>st</sup> January 2021 and the details will be forwarded on 20<sup>th</sup> January 2021.
