



## **CALL FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR THE EDUCATION CANNOT WAIT (ECW) MULTI YEAR RESILIENCE PROGRAMME (MYRP)**

The Government of Uganda has been implementing the Education Response Plan (ERP) for Refugees and Host Communities in Uganda since 2017 in line with the Comprehensive Refugee Response Framework. The Government is finalizing Phase II of the Costed Education Response Plan with support from Education Cannot Wait (ECW), the United Nations Global Fund for Education in Emergencies and protracted crisis and other organizations. ECW advocates for Multi-Year Resilience Programme and funding, working closely with Governments, public and private donors, UN agencies and Civil Society Organizations to leverage support, increase efficiency and ensure effective educational responses.

ECW has given indication of availability of funding support of about USD 26.95 million seed funding towards a broader, catalytic Multi-Year Resilience Programme (MYRP) costed at USD 192 million for three years. This ECW funding will support the implementation of the ERP II framework. The Ministry of Education and Sports is working with ECW and other organizations to implement this Multi-Year Resilience Programme (MYRP).

In line with the ECW guidelines, the Ministry of Education and Sports is soliciting for expression of interest (Eoi) from eligible organizations to become the Grant Agent for ECW MYRP. The selected Grant Agent, or all of the selected Grant Agents (if there is more than one) will be expected to provide effective grant management function as well as technical support on capacity building, coordination, child protection, gender, and inclusion throughout the implementation of the MYRP.
