ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible, the applicant **MUST**:

1. Be a staff in an organization or an enterprise, or academic staff in backbone of university or and research institution.
2. Be under the age of 45 at the time of application.
3. Have over 3 years of work experience.
4. Have an Honours bachelor's degree in the relevant field
5. Be in good health (formal medical check-up results from a public hospital is required).

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

1. All applicants are required to read the application guide carefully, prepare the application materials in strict accordance with its requirements, finish the online application both at www.campuschina.org and at the university application website and complete all the application procedures.
2. Carefully read instruction for Chinese Government Scholarship Information System (CGSIS) at www.campuschina.org and remember to choose **TYPE B** during the online application process.
3. All applicants are required to submit the soft copies of the following
 - a) A completed letter of Application
 - b) Two recommendation letters (PDF), one from the workplace; the other from a Professor in the University that the applicant graduated from.
 - c) Bachelor's or Master's Degree Certificate (PDF) and should be stamped by the Ministry of Education and Sports

- d) Personal Statement including study plan or research proposal with a minimum of 1000 words (PDF).
- e) Foreign Physical Examination Form from a Government Hospital (PDF).
- f) Passport photocopy (at least 18 months validity; Service or Diplomatic passport is not acceptable (WORD DOCUMENT).
- g) Certificate of non-criminal record (Police Clearance) (PDF).
