### Eligibility

- PhD applicants must have had an admission from a University in UK; and must have a Supervisor in the relevant field in at least one of the UK universities to which they are applying.
- 2. Applicants should hold a first degree of at least an Upper Second Class Honours in the relevant field.

- Applicants with foreign qualifications MUST have their academic documents EQUATED by the National Council for Higher Education.
- 4. Applicants for Masters programmes must have at least two years work experience in the relevant field.
