 - a) a minimum CGPA of 3.60 in the relevant field.
 - b) at least two years working experience in the relevant field.
- 3. Applicants must not be more than **25 years of age for Undergraduate** and not more than **35 years of age for Masters** at the time of application.
- 4. Those admitted on Government Scholarships/ Sponsorship should not apply.
- 5. Applicants with Foreign Qualifications should have their academic papers equated by UNEB for undergraduate applicants and NCHE for postgraduate applicants.
