#### **Eligibility:**

1. Born and currently resident and working in Karamoja.
2. Applicants who already hold a Master's Degree are not eligible.
3. Be able to demonstrate a strong commitment to the development of Karamoja and highlight how the proposed study could be used for positive change in Karamoja.
4. Have identified and selected three relevant courses from accredited universities in Uganda in the sectors of education; public health/ HIV; community development; human rights; gender and governance; water, environment and climate change; management, finance and audit.
5. Have two years' relevant post – graduate experience.
6. Be prepared to commit to two years working in Karamoja following graduation.
