Applicants ;-</li><li>2. should hold at a PhD in the field of Life Sciences</li><li>3. should be engaged in Scientific Research within the field of Life Sciences, focusing on advancing knowledge and contributing to sustainable Development</li><li>4. must be a Ugandan Nationality and conduct research at a recognized Laboratory in Africa.</li><li>5. Must be under 45 years at the time of application</li><li>6. should have a proposal outlining an innovative Research idea that can be completed within one year considering the facilities available to the applicant</li></ol>

	<p>7. should have a detailed workplan including the project activities, objectives and expected outcomes with a timeline showing completion within one year</p> <p>8. should have a comprehensive budget breakdown of USD 25,000 grant clearly demonstrating how the funds will be allocated to implement the proposed project eg materials, equipment, travel, publications etc</p> <p>9. should have a summary of the past research including publications and other supporting documents, with significant publications highlighted</p> <p>10. should have a detailed CV, including academic qualifications, position held, Research Experiences and current work.</p> <p>should have two recommendation letters from a Thesis Supervisor or peer in the Research Field (who is not part of the candidates' immediate environment</p>
